INDIVIDUAL SPRINT CHAMPIONSHIP - Thursday 29th April

- Map: Recently Updated Massey Campus Map
- Scale: 1:4000
 - Contour: 2.5 m (5m on the old version)
- Location: Palmerston North
- Terrain: A wonderfully complex campus area, generally flat in the park-like Massey University Palmerston North Campus.
- Level: Senior B/G, Intermediate B/G, Junior B/G, Y7-8 MF
- Start times: First starts from 2:00pm
- Planner Greg Sawyer

INDIVIDUAL LONG CHAMPIONSHIPS - Friday 30th April

- Map: Recently updated Scotts Ferry map
- Scale: 1:10,000 and 1:7500
- Contour: 2.5m
- Location: Scotts Ferry. At the end of Parewanui Rd
- Terrain: This area is typical forested dunes found along the Horowhenua Manawatu coast. Runnability is fast and open under the trees.
- Levels:
 - Senior Boys & Senior Girls Championship (Red), Standard (Orange) and Novice (Yellow)
 - Intermediate Boys & Intermediate Girls Championship (Orange) and Standard (Yellow)
 - Junior Boys & Junior Girls Championship (Yellow) and Standard (White) Yr7/8 Boys & Yr7/8 Girls Championship (Yellow) and Standard (White)
- Start times: First starts from 10.30am

RELAY CHAMPIONSHIPS – Saturday 1st May

- Map: Recently updated Massey Park and farm
- Scale: 1:4000
- Contour: 2.5m (5m on the old map version)
- Location: Near Massey University Campus
- Terrain: Park and farm area near the campus. Generally flat with a few hills to contend with for the longer courses.
- Level: All runners run the Standard Grade except Legs 1 and 3 of the Junior Boys and Girls, who run Championship Grade
- Start times: First Starts will be at 10.00am
- Teams: "Official teams" consist of 3 students, according to the Special Rules for New Zealand Secondary Schools Orienteering Championships (www.orienteering.org.nz/resources/rules).
